Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how **danyvin** uses cookies and similar technologies on **danyvin.com**. It works together with our **Privacy Policy**.

1) What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device by websites you visit. They can be **session** (deleted when you close the browser) or **persistent** (kept until they expire or you delete them). We may also use localStorage for certain preferences.

2) Your choices & consent

- You control cookies via our banner: Accept all, Reject non-essential, or Customise.
- You can withdraw or change your choices anytime via the **Cookie settings** link in the site footer.
- If your browser sends a **Global Privacy Control (GPC)** signal, we treat it as an opt-out of non-essential cookies/tags where applicable by law.
- You can also manage cookies in your browser (see section 6 below).

3) Categories we use

- **Strictly necessary** required for the site to function (authentication/session, security, basic preferences). These do not require consent.
- Functional enhance features (e.g., remembering UI choices).
- Analytics help us understand usage and improve the site.
- Marketing used for advertising/retargeting.

Current status (as of the date above): we use **only strictly necessary** cookies and consent-preference storage. **We do not set analytics or marketing cookies.**

4) What we set today (indicative)

Notes: Names and durations may change as we update our infrastructure. Any non-essential categories will be **off by default** and require your consent.

5) Third parties

Where third-party cookies are used (e.g., Cloudflare), their processing is governed by their terms and privacy notices. We minimise third-party tracking and do not use cross-site marketing tags.

6) Managing cookies in your browser

You can delete or block cookies via your browser settings. Helpful pages: **Chrome** (Settings \rightarrow Privacy and security \rightarrow Cookies and other site data), **Safari** (Preferences \rightarrow Privacy), **Firefox** (Settings \rightarrow Privacy & Security \rightarrow Cookies and Site Data), **Edge** (Settings \rightarrow Cookies and site permissions). Blocking necessary cookies may break the site.
